

The IPRO ESRD Network of New York can help resolve many concerns you may have about the care you receive as a dialysis patient.



The mission of the IPRO End Stage Renal Disease (ESRD) Network Program is to promote health care for all ESRD patients that is safe, effective, efficient, patient-centered, timely, and equitable.

Network staff can

<p>Advocate for patients' rights, depending on the situation.</p>	<p>~ Example: "My unit is too cold" With your permission, a Network staff member can contact your facility to find out if the temperature can be controlled.</p>
<p>Provide information and educational resources.</p>	<p>~ Example: "I need a fourth shift, and my facility does not offer one" The Network can provide you with a list of facilities in your area that offer a fourth shift (Dialysis Facility Compare tool available on www.medicare.gov)</p>
<p>Investigate concerns about issues related to quality of care.</p>	<p>~ Example: "I am upset about the care I am receiving at my facility" The Network can conduct a review of your medical record to evaluate the quality of care you are receiving.</p>
<p>Help patients understand their rights and help them navigate the ESRD care delivery system.</p>	<p>~ Example: "I don't agree with a policy at my facility" The Network can advocate on your behalf and could help you work with facility staff to find a compromise that would work for you and the facility.</p>

The Network collaborates with the New York State Department of Health to advocate for individuals and help resolve concerns about care received at dialysis facilities.
